Looking after all our water needs

Proclaimed public drinking water source areas

Purpose

The Department of Water is responsible for managing and protecting Western Australian water resources. In order to protect the catchment areas of our drinking water reservoirs and bore-fields, we define and arrange proclamation of water reserves, catchment areas and underground water pollution control areas.

Water reserves, catchment areas and underground water pollution control areas are collectively known as public drinking water source areas (PDWSAs). These areas are proclaimed under the *Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act 1909 (WA)* (MWSSD Act) or the *Country Areas Water Supply Act 1947 (WA)* (CAWS Act). By-laws created under these statutes enable this department to manage potentially polluting activities, regulate land use, inspect premises and to take the necessary steps to prevent or clean up pollution.

This note lists the PDWSAs which are currently proclaimed in Western Australia. The list will change when new proclamations, amendments and abolition of PDWSAs occur. Public notification is provided in the *Western Australian Government Gazette*, available online from the State Law Publisher <www.slp.wa.gov.au/gazette/gazette.nsf>.

Maps showing the location of each PDWSA are available online at <www.water.wa.gov.au> select *tools and data* > *maps and atlases* > *geographic data atlas*; then expand *environment* > *public drinking water source areas*. Navigation tools on the atlas page allow you to pan, add layers of interest, such as roads and zoom in or out to specific locations. Alternatively, maps used in the PDWSA proclamation process after 2004 are available online at the department's website at <<http://drinkingwater.water.wa.gov.au>>. The department has also prepared a register of PDWSAs for local government which is also available on the department's website listed above.
